

A Note about the Coronavirus (COVID-19) to Our Shoppers, Donors and Those We Serve

While our government and local health departments work to keep you and your family safe, we would like to reassure you that your health and well-being are top priorities for Goodwill as well. As a mission-based nonprofit organization, Goodwill cares deeply for the clients we serve and the many donors, shoppers and employees that allow us to help others in northeast Indiana every day.

We closely watch the evolving coronavirus (COVID-19) situation and guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control, Indiana State Department of Health and Allen County Department of Health. Actions taken to protect you, our employees, offices and stores from the spread include:

- Frequent cleaning of high-traffic areas and surfaces, including door handles, credit card pin pads, shopping cart handles, faucets, restrooms and more using a sanitizing cleaner.
- Making hand sanitizer available in high-traffic areas and client offices.
- We take health and safety seriously and follow health guidelines to reduce the spread of illness. Employees stay home if they are sick. We use hygiene precautions, such as regular hand washing for at least 20 seconds, using hand sanitizer with at least 60 percent alcohol and covering our noses and mouths when coughing and sneezing.
